 - Original text: (Article VII, Section 5) “The Circle of Sisterhood Committee will serve to evaluate requests for charitable donations from organizations to Panhellenic Council. The Circle of Sisterhood Committee will consist of 5-10 members from Panhellenic Chapters. Members must be in good standing with their chapter and maintain a 2.5 GPA. Recommendations for donations will be presented to the Panhellenic Council and a majority vote is required for approval.”
 - Proposed change: Change underlined text to “The Circle of Sisterhood Committee will consist of one member from each Panhellenic Chapter.”
 - Purpose: encourage total chapter participation in Circle of Sisterhood
 - Purpose: As Circle of Sisterhood is our Panhellenic community’s philanthropy, we think it would be most beneficial for our community to have each chapter involved & engaged in planning & executing our philanthropic initiatives. Additionally, this would provide the committee with a wide range of perspectives, allow Circle of Sisterhood to become a philanthropy that each of our chapters has a voice in, and create opportunities for more Panhellenic
